What is Blueline Laundry?

Blueline Laundry is a commercial laundry registered with the NDIS to provide supported work opportunities to people with disability. To work at Blueline you will need:

- Have supported employment funding listed in your plan.
- You will need to perform duties associated with the production and processing of linen within a commercial laundry environment, including sorting, conveyor use, loading/unloading washers, folding, blanket/towel folder, ironers, stacking on shelves, and being trained to meet quality standards (rewash)
- Be involved with the operations of a variety of machines and equipment as part of the production requirements.
- Understand and follow all safety requirements
- Be able to work in a team environment, understanding a problem and capable of reporting
- Be in a position to rotate in various roles as required (multi skilled)
- Be proactive towards on-the-job training support.

Can I work at Blueline Laundry?



You can apply for work at Blueline Laundry if you:

- have a disability
- o are over 18 years of age and have finished high school
- want to work
- need support to keep a job
- o are able to do the work that is done at Blueline Laundry
- have supported employment in your NDIS plan

Will I get paid?



Yes. You will receive an assessed wage depending on the sort of work you do.

You will also get superannuation and leave entitlements.

How often do I work?



The hours of employment will be negotiated with you depending on the work that is available.

What happens now?



When you apply, your name will go on our wait list.
